

Key Word Web

Stepping Stones : Storytelling

Materials : incl. materials

Type of exercise : written

Duration exercise : >60 min.

Objectives

The learner can give personal information.

Materials

Paper and pen

Instructions

Give each learner a sheet of paper.

- Ask the learners to make an association web around the keyword home.
 Let them associate freely, until the sheet is filled.
- Guide each learner individually. Ask to explain some associations.

Variant

• Other keywords are Childhood

Me Safety Happiness Passion Rejection

Advanced group Let the learners work in pairs. Correct the spelling.

Beginners group Help the learners with the spelling.

Closing up

Stress how important it is to know your own story and that all stories have a right to exist and are equally important.
