Objectives

The learner can ask and give information.

Materials

- Blackboard
- For each learner a copy with the questions

Preparation

Make a list with frequently asked questions, e.g.

What are you good at? What is your passion? What can I wake you up for? What will you be doing in five years? What did you want to be when you were a kid? Have I seen you before? Do you believe in God?

Instructions

- Write the questions on the blackboard or give each learner a copy with the questions.
- Ask the learners if these questions are also frequently asked in their native country.
- Ask if they find any of the questions awkward, too personal, original, silly...
- Ask them to add a FAQ.

Variant

To go deeper into the subject, you can ask the following questions: Do you ask personal questions? What is your answer to personal questions?
