

Title of the activity	CREATING YOUR OWN MUSEUM
Description	<p>Learners make their own museum.</p> <p>The museum can be a display of artefacts (e.g. objects) or a collection of art that is meaningful to them and that refers to a story or meaning in their lives.</p> <p>The participants can work individually or in small groups. Organise a gallery walk to present the museum.</p>
